The cloud is just a metaphor for the internet

SO WHAT IS CLOUD COMPUTING?

- Information you put on the internet such as a photo is stored in big servers instead of on your personal computer
- These means if something happens to your computer for instance it breaks, your photo will not be lost
- You can view your photo from any device that can access the internet





HOW TO READ A WEB ADDRESS

3 QUESTIONS TO ASK YOURSELF

1. Do you recognize the domain name?

- URL FOUND AFTER THE HTTP:// AND WWW. TO THE FORWARD SLASH
- INFORMS YOU ABOUT WHAT THE SITE IS ABOUT

What is the extension in the domain name?

- INDICATES THE TYPE OF ESTABLISHMENT THAT OWNS AND PUBLISHES THE DOMAIN
- .EDU, .GOV, .K12. MORE RELIABLE
- .COM, .ORG, .NET BEWARE, CAN BE PURCHASED BY ANYONE

Are you on a personal page?

- READ PAST THE FIRST FORWARD SLASH / FOR CLUES IF ON PERSONAL PAGE CREATED BY AN INDIVIDUAL
- COULD BE BIASED
- URL WITH JDICK AND TILDE ~ OR % TYPICALLY PERSONAL PAGE EVEN WITH EXTENSION .EDU

TOTALLY TRUSTWORTHY

You are guaranteed that these results are from a trusted authority. You don't have to verify them.

MORE MANAGEABLE

You are not dealing with the 1000s of messy results you would get from just googling. These are filtered and without duplicates.

FANTASTICALLY FOCUSED

You are not wasting time. It is focused on specific subject matter with legitimate, quality results.

AUDIENCE APPROPRIATE

You can use advanced search features to get results based on age, grade level, subject area, and reading level. It is meant for you!

RELIABLY REAL

You are dealing with up-to-date results that are factual and unbiased. You can access proper published information.
